

DISABILITY RIGHTS



People with disabilities are –



more vulnerable and more susceptible to the effects of climate crisis.

less likely to have access to adequate resources, information & services to adapt.

CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE



One billion young people are at extremely high risk of the effects of the climate crisis.



60% of young people across the world experience climate anxiety.

HEALTH



Air pollution is the single biggest threat to health in the UK, shortening 10s of 1000s of lives each year.



Lack of access to quality green space increases likelihood of poor physical & mental health.

REFUGEES & ASYLUM SEEKERS



People are 3x more likely to be displaced by cyclones, floods & wildfires than by conflict.



20 million people a year were internally displaced by extreme weather disasters over the last 10 years.

GENDER EQUALITY



Women are under represented in natural resource decision making & leadership.



Women are at greater risk of gender based violence owing to the crisis.

RACIAL JUSTICE



Black communities are disproportionately located in areas that are physically vulnerable.



Race has a greater influence on exposure to pollutants than poverty.
